

Dr. Sheriff Folarin in Rwanda, Gives Series of Talks to Officers from African Military High Commands

Texas State University professor, Dr. Sheriff Folarin is in Rwanda at the invitation of the Ministry of Defense and University of Rwanda to give strategic talks and mentorship to members of the Course 12 of the Senior Command and Staff Course of the country's war college. The RDF Defense and Staff College annually, hosts senior military officers from Botswana, Malawi, Zambia, Tanzania, Namibia, Uganda, Kenya, Ethiopia, South Sudan, Rwanda, Nigeria, and Senegal, on a Master of Strategic Studies course.

The program also has on board senior military instructors from Rwanda, Ghana, Kenya, and other countries of Africa and beyond. The Center for Conflict Management of the University of Rwanda coordinates it.

Dr. Folarin, who teaches in the Department of Political Science at Texas State University, is one of the few expatriates and professors across the world invited to engage the students in intense sessions of talks, lectures, and mentorship. Dr. Folarin has since 2020 been a regular guest of the Rwandan government for this intellectual and strategic enterprise.
